Dear Vladimir Shadrinov,

Please be advised that as of 5 February 2018, Fan Domains Ltd. ("Fan Domains") is in breach of its 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 19 March 2015 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

1. Fan Domains' failure to provide Registrar Services, as required by Section 3.1 of the RAA; and
2. Fan Domains' failure to provide and maintain accurate and current information as specified in the Registrar Information Specification ("RIS") and to notify ICANN within five days of any changes to such information, as required by Section 3.17 of the RAA.

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach.

In addition, Fan Domains has been deemed noncompliant in the following areas:

1. Fan Domains' failure to provide an interactive webpage providing free public query-based access to up-to-date data concerning all active registered names sponsored by Fast Domains for each top-level domain ("TLD") in which it is accredited, as required by Section 3.3.1 of the RAA;
2. Fan Domains' failure to escrow gTLD registration data, as required by Section 3.6 of the RAA;
3. Fan Domains' failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA

Additional Concerns

ICANN notes that the website for Fan Domains does not currently resolve and was unable to review the website to complete the compliance check. In addition, Fan Domains exhibits a pattern of non-responsiveness to renewal requests by registered name holders (RNHs) and ICANN compliance notices currently underway. ICANN is unable to contact Fan Domains by telephone or fax because the numbers are not operational.

ICANN requests that Fan Domains cure these breaches by 26 February 2018, 21 business days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

1. Demonstrate to ICANN that Fan Domains can operate as a registrar and provide Registrar Services;
2. Provide ICANN with a completed RIS form, including accurate and current contact information, the required supporting documentation and the location of any applicable information published on Fan Domains' website, as required by Section 3.17 of the RAA;
3. Provide an interactive webpage Whois service providing free public query-based access to up-to-date data concerning all active registered names sponsored by Fan Domains for each TLD in which it is accredited;
4. Deposit gTLD registration data on a weekly basis to an approved escrow agent and ensure that the deposits meet the required specifications;
5. Provide ICANN with corrective and preventative action(s), including implementation dates and milestones, to ensure that Fan Domains will timely respond to ICANN, RNH and public inquiries; and
6. Pay all past due accreditation fees.

If Fan Domains fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 26 February 2018, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

ATTACHMENT

Failure to provide Registrar Services

Section 3.1 of the RAA requires registrars to operate as a registrar for one or more gTLDs under the RAA. Fan Domains' failure to operate a website for the provision of registrar services, respond to requests from RNHs, or demonstrate to ICANN that it provides Registrar Services, is a breach of Section 3.1 of the RAA.

Failure to provide and maintain required contact information

Section 3.17 of the RAA requires registrars to maintain and provide to ICANN the information specified in the RIS. Fan Domains' failure to provide to ICANN and maintain accurate and current information as specified in the RIS, including a primary contact telephone number where Fan Domains can be reached for contractual purposes, is a breach of Section 3.17 of the RAA.

Failure to provide an interactive webpage Whois service

Section 3.3.1 of the RAA requires registrars to provide an interactive webpage Whois service providing free public query-based access to up-to-date data concerning all active registered names sponsored by the registrar. Fan Domains' failure to provide an interactive webpage Whois service is a breach of Section 3.3.1 of the RAA.

Failure to escrow gTLD registration data

Section 3.6 of the RAA requires registrars to submit an electronic copy of the data described in Sections 3.4.1.2 through 3.4.1.5 of the RAA to ICANN, or at the registrar's expense, to a reputable escrow agent mutually approved by the registrar and ICANN. Registrars shall submit the data on a schedule, under the terms, and in a format specified by ICANN. Fan Domains' failure to deposit gTLD registration data with an approved escrow agent under the required schedule and terms is a breach of Section 3.6 of the RAA.

Failure to pay accreditation fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. Fan Domains owes ICANN past due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
